

Restriction of Use of Hazardous Substances (RoHS)

Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 8 June 2011

and

Commission Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 of 31 March 2015 amending Annex II to Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the list of restricted substances

Dwyer Instruments, LLC certifies that to the best of its knowledge the Series TPT Industrial Pressure Transmitter meets the substance restrictions of the European Union's Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 8 June 2011, on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment. Meeting the restrictions means it does not contain any of the following substances in excess of the maximum concentration values in any homogeneous material, unless the substance is in an application that is exempt under the Directive:

(a) 0.1% by weight for lead, mercury, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls (PBB), polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE), Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) Phthalate (DEHP), Benzyl Butyl Phthalate (BBP), Dibutyl Phthalate (DBP), and Diisobutyl Phthalate (DIBP),

(b) 0.01% by weight for cadmium.
